
Bluebeam – Setting Bluebeam up to recognize Project

- Open Bluebeam Revu
- Click Revu upper left corner
- Click Preferences



- You can also press CTRL+K to bring up the Preferences dialog box
- Click Interface
- Click File Access

Opening a ProjectWise Document in Bluebeam

- Open Bluebeam Revu
- Click File
- Click Open
- ProjectWise should login using your Windows creditials if it does not then your username will be COV\networkID and your password will be your network login password
- You should now see the ProjectWise Datasource
- Navigate to the PDF that you want to open or view
- Check the box in the lower left corner if you want to view the document as read-only
