

Flashing Yellow Arrow Installation in Virginia

VDOT works hard to provide a roadway network that operates safely, efficiently, and effectively. In 2019, the Commonwealth Transportation Board approved the deployment of highly effective, low-cost safety improvements to help reduce serious injury and fatal crashes across the Commonwealth. This data-driven strategy focuses on proactively targeting locations with higher crash risk. The goal is not to wait for crashes to occur before we proactively treat high-risk locations on the roadway network!

**Flashing Yellow Arrow (FYA)** is a traffic signal indication for left turns that allows a driver to proceed when oncoming traffic is clear. Pesearch has shown that drivers are 20% less likely to crash when turning left at a signal with FYA.

Local agencies may apply for FYA implementation funding for eligible traffic signals through the Virginia Highway Safety Improvement Program (VHSIP). The

preferred FYA type is a traditional four-section head. Eligible FYA installations include retrofits of existing permissive left-turn phasing or protected-permissive left-turn phasing only. Protected-only left-turn phasing conversions to FYA are not eligible for funding as part of this initiative. Lower-cost FYA implementation locations will be prioritized for funding under this initiative, however locations requiring signal equipment or signal structure/pole upgrades are eligible for this round of FYA installation funding.

Local projects will be selected and funded based on a variety of criteria, including return on investment (ROI), a project's potential to meet Virginia's Highway Safety Investment Strategy goals, and project scope and feasibility.

Localities shall follow the locally administered project procedures described in the <u>LAP Manual</u><sup>2</sup>. All contract work is required to be eligible for federal funding.
