Proposed Limited Access Control Changes I-95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension Prince William County Stafford County

Willingness for Public Comment

The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) is accepting comments regarding proposed limited access control changes for the I-95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension project. This project will involve a change in limited access control. This project extends the Express Lanes 10 miles from just south of Garrisonville Road to Route 17 in Stafford County. Two reversible Express Lanes will be built in the existing median of I-95. New access points to Express Lanes will be built near the Route 17 and Route 630 (Courthouse Road) I-95 interchanges in Stafford and at Russell Road near Quantico Marine Corps Base in Prince William County.
