**Find out** about the proposed improvement for the section of Route 501 (LP Bailey Hwy) that starts 0.111 mile west of Route 501 and extends to 0.071 mile north of BUS. 360 in Halifax County. The purpose of this project is to improve safety at this intersection by constructing a single-lane roundabout.

**Review** the proposed project plans and the National Environmental Policy Act documentation in the form of a Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or at VDOT's Lynchburg District Office, located at 4219 Campbell Avenue in Lynchburg. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of personnel to answer your questions.

Property impact information, relocation assistance policies and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above address and will be available at the public hearing.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places is also available for public review.
