




Background

- VDOT and Fairfax County are working together to develop and construct the Compton Road Shared Use Path (SUP) Project as part of the I-66 Trail Network
- The project will include a bridge over Cub Run for the SUP
- The path will improve mobility and travel choices for pedestrians and bicyclists in this area
- The Compton Road SUP will provide a connection to surrounding existing and/or future trails including connectivity between the Bull Run Special Events Center and Cub Run Trail System
- A Virtual Public Information Meeting was held on December 9, 2021




I-66 Trail Network





Existing Cub Run Trail System




Existing Surrounding Trail Networks

Project Overview

- SUP South of I-66
 - South of the I-66 bridges to Bull Run Special Events Center Drive (including a crossing of Compton Road)
 - Approximately 430' long and 10' wide
- SUP North of I-66
 - North of the I-66 bridges and will provide a connection with the existing Cub Run Trail
 - Approximately 380' long and 10' wide
 - Includes additional tasks that will extend the construction duration
 - SUP bridge over Cub Run
 - Relocating a water line for the project fill slopes






Compton Road Shared Use Path Section A-A










Compton Road Shared Use Path Section C-C





Shared Use Path Bridge Over Cub Run Section D-D






Right-of-Way (ROW) Acquisitions



- Project requires three (3) proposed partial acquisitions
 - One Residential Lot
 - Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority
 - Fairfax County Park Authority
- These impacts are subject to change as final design is developed
- Utility easements are not shown at this time
- Each property acquisition is unique and is discussed on a caseby-case basis after Right-of-Way Notice to Proceed

National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969



- Level of environmental document based on NEPA significance of impacts (context + intensity)
- Project qualifies for a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion (PCE) due to very limited impacts under 23 CFR 771.117.
- Preparation of PCE is underway


