### Alternatives Retained for Study

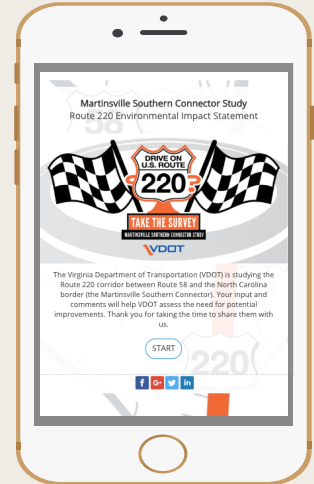

### Field Work Underway



VDOT has begun preliminary engineering and environmental data collection for the study in order to investigate potential environmental impacts of each alternative advanced in the study. To effectively study these potential impacts, VDOT is actively working in the Route 220 study area to collect existing resource data. The activities involved may include, but are not limited to: identification of wetlands and streams, collecting soil samples, monitoring existing noise levels, and other transportation design-related evaluations.
